### JUDGES JAM

Deaf Dog and the Indictments bills itself as the "world's only (almost) all-judge band." It's hard argue with the claim. Made up of six District of Columbia Superior Court judges (and one civilian) the band played its second concert of the year on April 2 at Saint Elizabeth's Hospital in Washington. The band formed during a judicial retreat in 2005, said Judge

**John Campbell**, who plays bass guitar and goes by the nickname

"Trashcan." (The name was earned thanks to a defendant who once threw a trash can at his head.) Judge **A. Frank Burgess Jr.**, i.e. "Professor," plays keyboard and said the band specializes in tunes from the '60s and '70s. The band has played the Kennedy Center's Millenium Stage, local bars and at community events. "We thought that would be a great opportunity to get out and do something in the community," Campbell said. Other band members include judges **Russell Canan** ("Top Dog") and **William Jackson** ("Dawgg"); magistrate judges **John McCabe** ("Cartwheel") and **William Nooter** ("Blue Dog"); and Marc Feldman ("Hound Dog"), a psychologist. Campbell said Deaf Dog's next performance will likely be sometime this summer. — Zoe Tillman
