On consideration of the opinion issued by this Court on March 11, 2010, and it appearing that the opinion failed to include information regarding the effective date of respondent's disbarment and the effect upon respondent's failure to file a compliant affidavit pursuant to D.C. Bar Rule XI, § 14 (g), it is

ORDERED, *sua sponte*, that the opinion is amended to the effect that: (a) respondent's disbarment is effective thirty days from the date of the amended opinion; and (b) for the purpose of seeking reinstatement to the Bar, the period of disbarment shall not be deemed to begin until respondent files a sufficient affidavit pursuant to D.C.
