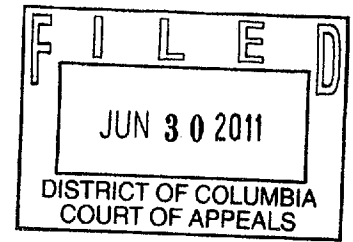

FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk shall reissue the mandate forthwith.


